 - b) What story in the Scriptures moves you to repent of your sins? Matthew 27:27-44
 - c) How can a person become genuinely sorry for his or her sins?
- 4) Why we shouldn't judge others
 - a) Romans 3:9-12
 - b) How can we avoid falling into the sin of condemning others for the same failings that we ourselves are guilty of?
 - c) Luke 15:12-32 Why was the older brother in the wrong to judge his younger brother?
 - d) Is it ever appropriate to point out someone else's failings?
